6. Vocational training re-started with the financial assistance of **FHF**.
7. Psycho-therapy department introduced with the financial assistance of **FHF**.

8. Ward-I fitted with Gas heaters, with the assistance of individual Philanthropists.
9. Electric water coolers, exhaust fans & water heaters installed with the assistance of individual Philanthropists.
10. State of art Physiotherapy equipment provided by **FHF**.
11. Numerous sewing machines provided to the deserving patients with the assistance of **FHF & individual philanthropists**.
12. **KFW** provided modern most equipment for the re-establishment of the orthopedic workshop.
